Pet Licensing Information Guide (2007)

Purpose:

Pet licensing helps ensure that all dogs and cats within the municipality are registered for identification and safety purposes. Licensing also supports animal control services and shelters.

Who Needs a Licence:

All dog and cat owners residing within Greenfield municipal limits are required to obtain a valid pet licence.

Application Process:

1. Visit the municipal office or authorized licensing agents.
2. Provide proof of rabies vaccination for your pet.
3. Provide identification details of the pet (breed, age, color).
4. Pay the applicable licensing fee.

Renewal:

Licences must be renewed annually. Notices may be mailed to registered pet owners.

Fees:

Licensing fees vary depending on pet type and sterilization status. Discounts may be available for spayed or neutered animals.

Compliance:

Failure to license a pet may result in fines or penalties.
